From the desk of Dereck...

Put Nothing on Top of Your Bible

Many years ago, I was in Worship in a congregation in Gauteng. The church was packed, and a young man placed his Bible on the floor beside his pew. An older brother tried to get his attention and said, in no uncertain terms, that he must never put his Bible on the floor or put anything on top of it. He was not making an idol or shrine out of his Bible but rather showing respect for God's Word.

It is now 30 years later. If you enter my home or drop by the pew where I sit, you will find my Bible sitting on top of whatever else is there. If it is not, you know I didn't put it there. This lesson got my attention, and although not appreciated in my younger days, it lingers in my life, and I guess I am a bit like him.

Where do you put your Bible? What do you put on top of your Bible? I am not concerned with the physical placement of your Bible, but with its spiritual placement. Have you put it in your heart? Does it guide your feet and tongue? Is its message first in your life, or does something else occupy the pedestal of your life?

How can we benefit from keeping the Bible "on top" in our lives?

Psa. 119:1 – can be blessed and blameless

Psa. 119:9 – a young man can keep his way pure

Psa. 119:28 - my soul can be comforted

Psa. 119:46 - I do not need to be ashamed

Psa. 119:50 - comfort in times of affliction

Psa. 119:66 – I can have discernment and knowledge

Psa. 119:97 - can have wisdom

Psa. 119:104 – can hate evil so as to avoid it

Psa. 119:116 - can be sustained and filled with hope

Do I need to go on? When we put the Word of God first in our lives and put nothing else above it, blessings can come our way.

Oh, how I love your law! It is my meditation all day. Your commandment makes me wiser than my enemies, for it is ever with me.
